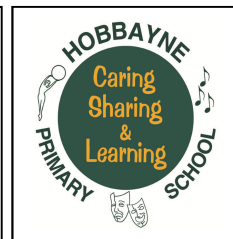

VISIT VENUE: Ealing Synagogue, 15 Grange Road, Ealing, London W5 5QN

PURPOSE:

As part of our RE studies on Judaism this year, to further our knowledge, understanding and respect of different religions, we will be visiting the Ealing Synagogue to learn more about Judaism.

ACTIVITIES:

The children will find out about the layout and features of a synagogue and learn about the history of Ealing Synagogue. They will complete some worksheets and have the chance to ask questions about the Synagogue.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS (including lunch and clothing):

The pupils will travel by public transport and walking. We will take the E1 bus from the Greenford Avenue to Ealing Broadway and walk the 10 minutes to the Synagogue.

Children are to wear the correct school uniform and footwear and bring a warm waterproof jacket should it be wet/cold. The children will be given a high visibility jacket so they can be easily identified on the journey. Children can bring a plastic water bottle for the trip.

Lunch: As the children are returning near to lunchtime, normal lunchtime arrangements apply on this day. We will not be bringing lunch with us, so please ensure your child has a hearty breakfast.

COST DETAILS & PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS:

There will be no charge for this trip.

VOLUNTEER HELPERS:

We will require adult helpers per class to make this a safe and enjoyable visit.

It is preferred that adult helpers hold a DBS check. We can accept offers of help from those without a DBS check to ensure this trip is able to go ahead.
