Action since last meeting

- VL emailed PTA so that PTA can meet to talk about fundraising and how the school council can help.
- VL arranged to meet Eleanor (WE foundation)
- Y5 to no longer bring in pencil cases

Role of school council

- VL to order red school council badges, like the prefect badges.
- School council suggestion box in classrooms

Playtime

- Y1 and 2 happy with playtime and quiet area activities offered (pompoms, bracelets, Lego)
- Suggestion that there is an option for an inside activity e.g. board games.
- Suggestion to use different playgrounds at lunchtimes e.g. Y6 to use the main playground as quiet area once it is free or to section off playgrounds more.

Behaviour

- Messages sent home to parents when children are in reflection.
- Suggestion of playtime 'bans'/ missing playtime
- Suggestion of children being excluded from fun activities.

Behaviour around school.

- Pushing in in the line
- Talking when teacher not looking
- Mixed messages – told that you will practice lining up and lose playtime tomorrow but then it doesn't happen. Children remember but they don't tell the teachers and remind them. It's the ones who don't line up properly who remember. The children who do line up well get dragged into it if it's the children in front or behind them.
- Suggestion that Buddies/Play supporters/ prefects keep an eye on lines and help younger year groups at the end of playtime

- Buddies/Play supporters/ prefects etc to give out certificates in high flyers.

Fundraising

- Blue Peter Children in Need Bring and Buy sale
- Books for classrooms
- Playground equipment and books

Environmental issues

- Rubbish on the playgrounds from snacks
- Fruit peel to be composted for use by gardening club

Rewards

- Y1, 2, Y3 happy with sticker books
- Y4+ not happy with sticker books. Dojo points.
- Stickers often get lost or they forget to stick them in their books and they end up at home. Stickers are hard to earn and you don't get enough to get through the sticker books. There isn't really a reward for finishing the book. Children steal stickers or stick in stickers from old books.
- Some classes have wow moments boards
- Some classes have good circles which say 1 sticker, 2 stickers, 3 stickers which they like
- Suggestion that we have wristbands which you can earn once you've got your bronze sticker book etc.
