Dear Year 4 Parents and Carers,

RE: NETHERCOTT FARM TRIP – JULY 5TH - JULY 12TH 2019

We are writing to you about a school journey for Year 4 and 5 pupils. This letter is going to those children in Year 4 who are Pupil Premium to enable them to have the chance to go on this fantastic week's experience before moving to Year 5. Although there is a further opportunity to go in Year 5, there are only 39 spaces available each trip, which is why we would like to offer you this first chance.

Nethercott is part of the 'Farms for City Children' project initially set up by the writer Michael Morpurgo. The organising charity has been in operation for many years and we were fortunate to have a very successful trip there in March, this year. The experience at Nethercott is highly educational, rich and rewarding. Children live as farmers for the week, tending the animals and observing the two farmers, David and Graham at work. We will be giving the children further information about the programme over the coming weeks. You can also visit the FFCC website on www.farmsforcitychildren.org

The price of the journey is **£340.00** for seven nights (the actual costs is £600 much of which is subsidised by the Farm's charity & Kelvin Grove). This price includes transport by coach and full board and must be paid 2 weeks before departure. A small amount of pocket money will be needed for the farm shop. If you would like to reserve a place for your child, please complete the slip below and return it as soon as possible with a **£40 deposit**. There is a maximum of 20 places.

Families who are in receipt of free school meals or have received free meals in the last six years, are entitled to a subsidy paid by the school making the cost **£270.00** to cover the cost of the board and lodging.

Places will be offered on a first come, first serve basis and on condition that your child's behaviour is acceptable.
