Monday 20th May 2019: Team- building day at Go Ape! Battersea Park.

The children are going to attend a day's activities at Go Ape! in Battersea Park. The children will be accompanied by myself, Mr Gibbs (PE specialist) and Mrs Blanks (Teacher). We will walk to Sydenham, get the Southern service from Sydenham to Battersea Park and then walk through Battersea Park to Go Ape.

The children will be taking part in the Junior Tree Top Course with a maximum height of 6 metres. Once we arrive at the centre, children will have a safety talk from centre staff and will then be escorted around the course by qualified instructors. We will also have an hour of team building games led by centre instructors.

You will need to provide a packed lunch for your child which should not contain fizzy drinks, sweets or **nuts** (due to pupil allergies). For children in receipt of *free school meals or universal free school meals* a school packed lunch will be provided. Lunch needs to be fully disposable and in a named plastic carrier bag.

Children do not need to wear school uniform on this trip. We have been advised that children should wear long sleeves, long trousers and trainers. Children should also wear a waterproof coat or a sunhat depending on the weather.

There is a cost for parents of £10.00 per child for this trip (the cost per child is £20.00 but the school will cover half of the cost.)
