It's that time of year again! World Book Day is on **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2018**. We have a number of things planned in the build up to celebrate the event this year.

### Author workshops – Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February & Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> February

We are pleased to announce that we have two local children's authors: Chitra Soundar and Tamara Macfarlane visiting the school to lead some interactive workshops for the children. There is a workshop for each year group from Nursery to Year 6 and there will also be the opportunity to buy copies of these books at the Book Fair on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> February.
