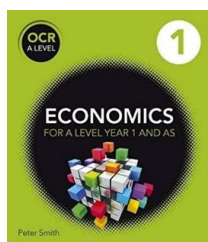
Year 12

Assessment Point	Area of Study
1. November (Term 1)	Students will develop an understanding of microeconomics: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Microeconomic theory• Theoretical working of the free market• Imperfections and market failures
2. January (Term 2)	Full mock examination paper- covering the topics above
3. April (Term 2)	Students will develop an understanding of macroeconomics: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Macroeconomy functions on a domestic and global level• Policy approaches• Changes in macroeconomics over time
4. June/July (Term 3)	One paper assessing all of the topics covered in macro and microeconomics.

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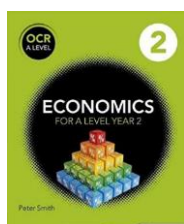
