Do not ride bicycles or scooters on the school grounds

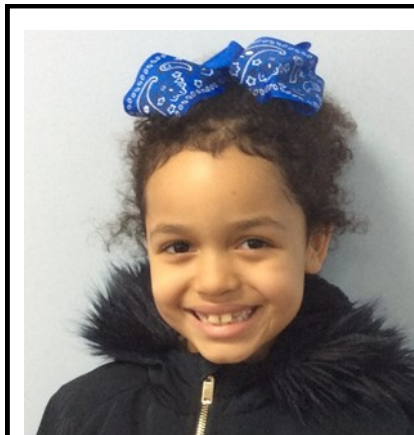
