Young Victoria Museum Feedback

We would just to say thank you to all the parents who visited the Young Victoria Museum on the last Friday of last half term. We really appreciate your interest and support and value your feedback. 50 Parents completed the questionnaires on the day.

Here is some of the feedback we received from parents:

- 88% rated their experience when visiting the museum as excellent .
- 82% said that their children were fully inspired during the week to explore the arts and learn about history.
- 98% said that their child/ren shared what they have learnt with their parents at home.
- 88% of parents feel that the school provides enough opportunities for parents to view their children's work.

These pupils are working towards their Arts Award, where they will spend time each week putting together a portfolio investigating the work of artists over the course of the term.

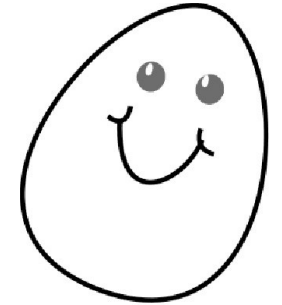
