The Tour of Britain Bike It Race - 6th October to 17th October 2014

In honour of the 2014 Tour de France cycling race, we will be taking part in the school 'Tour of Britain Bike It Race' from 6th October to 17th October 2014 as part of our school commitment to promoting healthy and environmentally conscious travel.

The aim is to cover the total route distance of the official Tour of Britain segment (840miles!) over the course of two weeks. From the 6th to the 17th October 2014, every child and member of staff who walks to school will earn 1 mile, and those who bike or scoot will earn 2miles for our school total.
