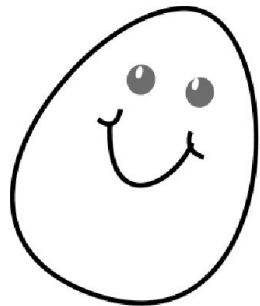

The Health Spot - New Regulations For Healthy School Dinners

To help in improving and maintaining the health of pupils the following regulations are now mandatory for local authority schools, new free schools and schools that convert to academy status.

They stipulate:

- one or more portions of vegetables or salad as an accompaniment every day
- at least three different fruits and three different vegetables each week
- an emphasis on wholegrain foods in place of refined carbohydrates
- an emphasis on making water the drink of choice
- limiting fruit juice portions to quarter pints (150ml)
- restricting the amount of added sugars or honey in other drinks to 5%
- no more than two portions a week of food that has been deep-fried, batter-coated or breadcrumb-coated
- no more than two portions of food that include pastry each week
- a portion of milk (lower fat and lactose reduced) to be made available once a day

As an academy founded between 2010-2014, Kenningtons Primary is not obliged to follow these regulations. However we are happy to report that the school already meets these requirements in all aspects apart from the provision of milk. At Kenningtons we promote the drinking of water during the lunch-break and as required throughout the day.
