Easter Cake Competition

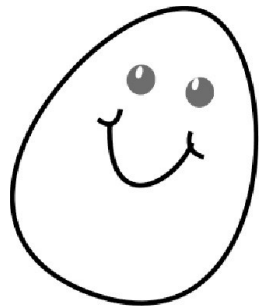
Our Easter Cake Competition will be on Friday 27th March 2015. On this day the school will close at 12:00pm and will re-open in the afternoon for the competition.

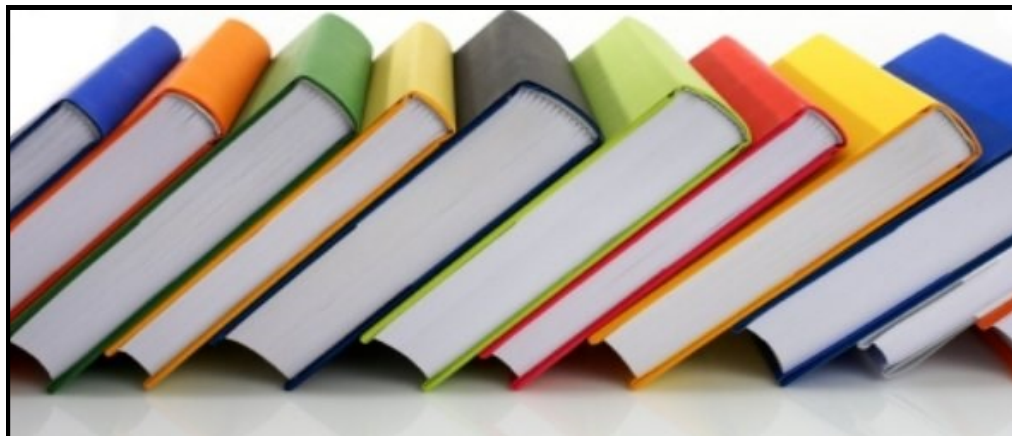

Local Activities - Easter 2015


Blackshots, Belhus Park, Belhus Park Golf Club and Corringham are running a number of timetabled activities during Easter 2015.
