School Attendance—Penalty Notice Code of Conduct for Unauthorised Absence from School

We have received a letter from Thurrock Council Education Welfare Service about how **Penalty Notices** will be implemented within Thurrock.

Please note that from 1st May 2014 schools can make referrals which may result in Parents being fined because of unauthorised absences.

Their letter states that “regular and punctual attendance at school is a legal requirement for pupils and is essential if pupils are to maximise the opportunities available to them. It is a parent’s responsibility to ensure that their child attends regularly.”

Term time holiday is marked as an unauthorised absence on school register.

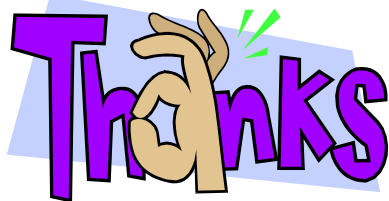
PE kits must be in school every day.
