In 2017/18 King Alfred School students achieved success in all areas of school life including an excellent performance in public exams.

The GCSE results were outstanding and richly deserved by our students, 57% of all grades were A*A or 9-7. This represents our best GCSE performance in many years. 17% of all grades in the new metric grading system were awarded '9's (above the A*), far surpassing the national average of 4.5%. Furthermore, 95% of all grades were in the A*-C or 9-4 range.

These are a truly excellent set of results, richly deserved by our students who have worked exceedingly hard this year. This shows that outstanding academic success does not have to mean pressure and stress.

At A level our results were in the top 10% nationally for value-added for the third year running, and are a testament to the hard work of the students, the strength of teaching and the unique experience that our vibrant Sixth Form offers. Each year our leavers go on to the universities of their choice and this year maintained this excellent record. From September, KAS students will find themselves in prestigious institutions ranging from top universities to cutting edge art colleges.

I congratulate all of our students and look forward to hearing of their future successes.

Top university destinations over the last five years, 2014-18

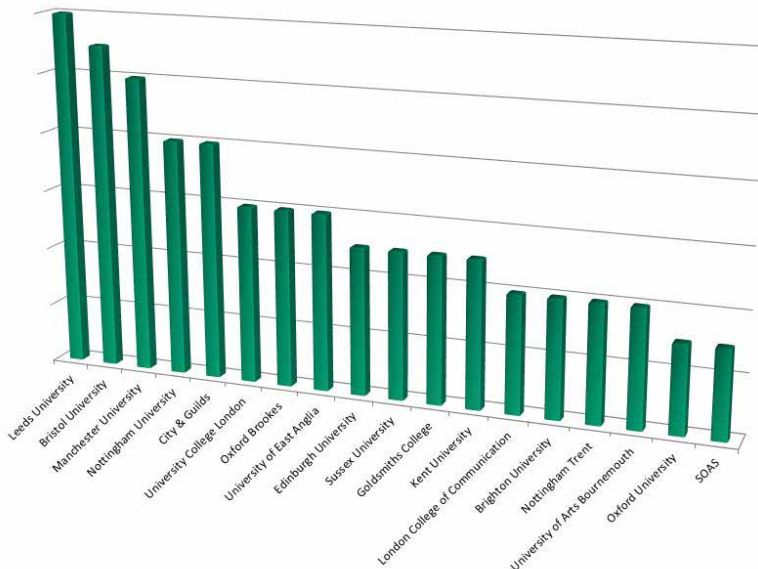
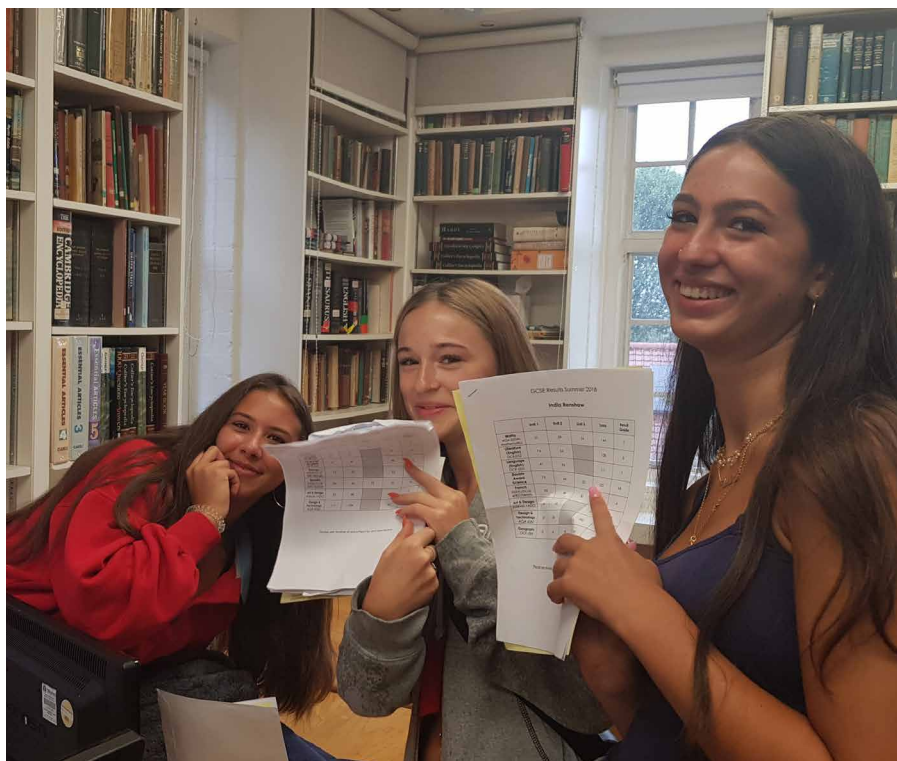


Chart shows relative proportions of numbers of acceptances at universities by King Alfred students 2014-18
