Lawn Primary School is a community school that was established in 1960s. We are a two form entry primary school with a before and after school care club on site run by the school.

We have our own school kitchen, which cooks delicious lunches from fresh.

The design of the school includes extensive security measures to ensure the safety of the children whilst they are at school. There are two separate play spaces – one each for the Infants and Juniors and includes a large school playing field. The building also provides facilities for the disabled by incorporating wide doors and corridors, specialist toilet facilities and lift facilities.

There is flexible ability grouping within each class and opportunities for focused teaching across year groups.

Our current admission size for FS2 is 60 which is split into 2 classes of 30. In Key Stage 2 the class size is 32 with a year group limit of 64.



Teaching is outstanding and this brings out the best in every pupil.

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High expectations are reflected throughout the school.
