Year 7 Spanish

1. Course & Subject Information

Students are taught in tutor groups for Spanish in Year 7. Topics studied build on the knowledge that may have been acquired in Primary school, although any student who did not study Spanish in Primary school is supported through after-school clubs, lunch-time catch up sessions and in-class support from the teacher. The Year 7 course starts to prepare students for the GCSE, but also teaches students about the culture, history, gastronomy, geography, music and literature of Spain and other Spanish-speaking countries.
