Dear Parents / Carers

We have a staff case of Hand, foot and mouth disease in Jeffers class (Usborne Cluster).

Hand, foot and mouth disease is easily passed on to other people. It is spread in coughs, sneezes and poo.

To reduce the risk of spreading hand, foot and mouth disease:

- wash your hands often with warm soapy water – and teach children to do
- use tissues to trap germs when you cough or sneeze
- bin used tissues as quickly as possible
- do not share towels or household items – like cups or cutlery
- wash soiled bedding and clothing on a hot wash

We have arranged for a deep clean of the class and nearby toilets.
