The Merchant Taylors' and St Helen's Schools Phab week is an annual residential camp that has been based on the school site of Merchant Taylors' School in Middlesex for over 45 years. We organise a wide variety of activities that are fun and exciting that take place on the school site and in and around London. The week aims to bring together young people with and without a physical or learning disability, and to provide respite for the guests' long-term carers.

This unique residential week involves 40 trained members of the schools' Year 12 and 13 students taking responsibility for entertaining and caring for the 20 disabled teenagers during the week.

Last year, guests participated in the following:

Trips- flying, bowling, shopping, soft play area (Thames Valley Playground), London Eye.

On site activities - fancy dress disco, games, a musical gig, petting zoo, arts and crafts, swimming, cooking and much, much more.

The schools site and its facilities are wheelchair accessible. The sleeping accommodation is split into male and female, using the former boarding house and main school buildings. All meals are provided and we aim to meet individual dietary requirements. There are members of staff on hand and a nurse on call to help everyone have a great time in a safe and caring environment whatever their ability.
