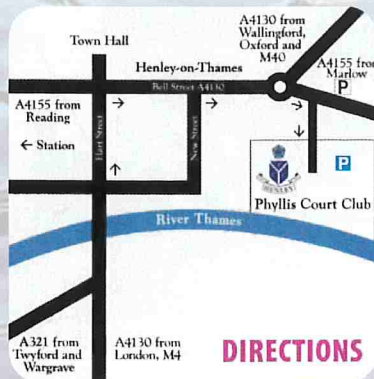

Regatta for the Disabled offers a fun filled day on and by the River Thames for those with disabilities and their families.

This event is held at Phyllis Court and offers accessible activities not always available to people of all ages and abilities.

The land based activities are all interactive and include a petting zoo, circus skills, climbing wall, rowing machine, Punch and Judy, and craft workshops.

Free trips on the river are also organised. Rivertime can hold up to 5 wheelchairs and we have 2 x 12 seater motorboats and a Bell boat which run all day.
