



HOME TO SCHOOL TRANSPORT INFORMATION MEETINGS FOR FAMILIES OF SEND 16-18 PUPILS

The Council will be holding meetings to provide information on what changes have been made to the home to school transport service, why it needed to change and what this will mean for you. The presentation will explain in detail charging bands based on distance travelled, increasing independent travel training for eligible young people aged 16-18 years and the new allocation of dedicated individual travelling assistants for student support.
