Year 1 Transition for Parents and Children

- Parents will get the opportunity to meet the Year 1 staff team.

Our current reception children will spend the whole day in their new classrooms, with their new teacher on July 12th. They have already started to pop upstairs, into the Year 1 area of the school in small groups to help them to become familiar with the Y1 classrooms and toilets. The Reception teachers have started to take the children out at playtimes to get used to that routine and to experience more whole school lessons.
