### **EXTERNAL MODERATION (LOCAL AUTHORITY)**

A few weeks ago, the Local Authority informed the school that they had selected Millbrook to be externally moderated this year for both Reception and Year 2 assessment judgements. The Reception classes were moderated on Tuesday 15th May and the Y2 moderation will take place on Friday 15th June.

The reception moderation went really well. The moderators chose a selection of pupils on the day and the teachers had to share the evidence they had on those children and talk through the judgements they had made. The moderators documented that the teachers knew the children extremely well and had an excellent understanding of how to assess them accurately. They also said that there was plenty of evidence to support decisions and that parents and children are effectively contributing to the process. They were pleased the reception teachers had already moderated with other schools too. Well done reception team!

### **Y3 Debating Workshop**

Following the success of the after school debating club run by Louise Watters and Miss Miller, Year 3 have now signed up to be part of the 'National Noisy Classroom' event which Millbrook will host on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> June. Children from other local schools will join our year 3 children to learn debating skills through a training workshop. After which they will have the opportunity to have a debate with pupils from the other schools.
