Dear Families,

This week the children have been learning ways to bounce-back after a disappointment. We read a story about the youngest child in a family who was not allowed to go camping with his two older siblings. The children were able to relate to their own disappointments such as not being able to have a play date, not being allowed to be bought a toy they want or not being allowed on a ride because they were too small. The story taught children that one way to bounce-back is to start doing an alternative activity (a distraction) to cheer themselves up rather than sulking. We also talked about not saying “no” to adults who are trying to help you to bounce-back by offering ideas. We are calling it ‘being a bouncy-ball’, not a ‘bean-bag’ because bean bags don’t bounce-back. It would be helpful if you try out using some of these ideas at home, as in most households there are plenty of occasions when children need to be/will be disappointed about something.
