<p>CORE ENGLISH</p> <p>Practice forming upper case and lower case letters.</p> <p>This can be done through writing or a multisensory approach e.g. writing in the sand (photos can be stuck in).</p>	<p>CORE ENGLISH</p> <p>Weekly reading (RWI and home reading book). *Please ask your carer to add a comment to the <u>reading record</u> to let us know how you got on.</p>	<p>CORE MATHS</p> <p>Learn to spell the numbers 1-20 in words. For example: 8 eight, 12 twelve</p>	<p>CORE MATHS</p> <p>Review number bonds to 10 ($6+4=10$). Use the pattern to learn your number bonds to 20 ($16+4=20$, $14+6=20$) Challenge: Use the patterns to learn number bonds to 100 ($60+40=100$)</p>	<p>PSHE/VALUES</p> <p>Make a poster about kindness. Ex: How to be kind to others. A time when you showed kindness</p>
<p>IPC SCIENCE</p> <p>Test the strength of different materials. For example, paper, cardboard, plastic, metal, etc. Record this in any way you like.</p>	<p>IPC RESEARCH</p> <p>Choose a famous building from around the world. What country is it in? Why is it famous? When was it built? What is it used for?</p>	<p>IPC ART/DT</p> <p>Create a model of your house. You can create this using resources of your choice e.g. lego, cardboard, plasticine. Take a photo and stick it in.</p>	<p>IPC HISTORY/GEOG</p> <p>Look at buildings in your local area. Are they old or new? How do you know? You might ask your neighbours or shopkeepers how old their building is.</p>	<p>IPC PROJECT</p> <p>Design a building for a superhero that lives in cold weather. You may present this how you like e.g. drawing, building, on the computer.</p>
<p>ENGLISH</p> <p>Write 5-8 sentences about yourself. This can include information about your family, pets, hobbies, etc.</p>	<p>ENGLISH</p> <p>Choose a page from your favourite book and think of a story to go with it. You can record this by writing, recording your voice, acting, a picture plan, etc</p>	<p>MATHS</p> <p>What things in your house can hold liquid? How much can they hold? Which object can hold the most? Can you put them in order from least to most?</p>	<p>MATHS</p> <p>Make some cupcakes for you and your family. Decorate them with your favourite sweets. Put the same amount of sweets on each one. How many sweets altogether?</p>	<p>EXPERIENCE</p> <p>Taste a fruit or vegetable that you haven't tried before. What did it taste like? Did you like it?</p>
