CORE MATHS

Learn to spell the numbers 1 - 40 in words.
For example: 22 twenty two, 35 thirty five

CORE MATHS

Review number bonds to 10
 $6+4=10$. Use the patterns for number bonds to 20 then 100
 $16+4=20$, $14+6=20$
 $(60+40=100)$ Challenge:: How many ways can you make a number?

PSHE/VALUES

Draw and label or write about a person who you think has been brave (courageous) e.g. family member, friend, famous person.

IPC SCIENCE

Test different materials at home to see if they are waterproof. Would they make a good roof for a building?

IPC RESEARCH

Create a poster or a leaflet on a London landmark. For example, The Shard, The Gherkin, The London Eye, St Pauls, The Tower of London, etc.

IPC ART/DT

Draw a picture of your home. This can be of the outside or a map on the inside. Focus on details e.g. shape of their door, door handle, bell, etc.

IPC HISTORY/GEOG

See if you can find an interesting fact about Hong Kong. Rehearse your facts ready to share in a show and tell with your class. Bring in pictures if you like.

IPC PROJECT

Can you make a building with four walls using unusual materials? E.g. bed sheets/blankets, food, books etc.

ENGLISH

Write 5-6 sentences describing your bedroom e.g. the colour, furniture, walls, floor, view from window.

ENGLISH

Choose a fairy tale and write a description about your favourite character.
e.g. Jack and the Beanstalk, Rumpelstiltskin, The Gingerbread Man.

MATHS

Draw pictures and label them showing what you do in the evening when you get home from school (in time order) e.g. I eat dinner then I read a book before I go to bed or Walk home, have a snack etc.

MATHS

Make biscuits (or use fruit) and give some of your delicious biscuits to someone else.
Write a number sentence to show this e.g. Miss Dixon had 4 biscuits and she gave Miss Dawson 2. ($4 - 2 = 2$)

EXPERIENCE

Write about a new place that you have visited recently. Where was it? What did you do there? Why should we go and visit it too?
