Week 2: Week beginning 10th September 2018

The following words all contain a 'soft g' which makes a 'j' sound. This sound is spelt 'g' or 'ge'.

Week 3: Week beginning 17th September 2018

The following words all have a 'c' in them which makes the sound 's' (sometimes called 'soft c'). Also, words beginning with 'c' followed by the vowel 'a', 'o' or 'u' the 'c' is hard (sounds like 'k').

Week 4: Week beginning 24th September 2018

The following words all have a silent letter in them. Silent 'k' is always followed by 'n' and the 'n' is always followed by a vowel. Silent 'w' is often followed by 'r' and the 'r' is always followed by a vowel. Silent 'g' is often followed by 'n' and the 'n' is often followed by a vowel. (Not many of these.)

Week 5: Week beginning 1st October 2018

The following words have a 'le' sound at the end of them. They also contain the vowel sounds (a, e, i, o, u).

Week 6: Week beginning 8th October 2018

The following group of words have a 'le' sound at the end of them. They also contain the vowel sounds (a, e, i, o, u). Words ending 'el' or 'al' are much less more common than words ending 'le'. Unlike the 'le' ending, 'el' and 'al' endings often follow letters which are not ascenders or descenders.

Week 7: Week beginning 15th October 2018

The following words have a 'le' sound at the end of them using the letters 'il' and 'ol'. Words ending 'il' or 'ol' are much less more common than words ending 'le', 'el' or 'al'.
