MATHS Write a maths problem story that involves all four operations. E.g. One day a farmer shared 24 seeds between himself and his 5 friends. One farmer lost 2 of his seeds and another farmer bought 3 more. When they all planted their seeds, a tree blossomed from each. Each tree grew 3 apples.

EXPERIENCE Grow your own vegetable garden. You can grow your vegetable inside or outside. When your vegetable has grown, enjoy it in a salad! (Your vegetable does **not** have to be fully grown by the end of this term but you can bring in pictures of its progress.)
