### **Reception Places 2016**

If you have been offered a Reception place at Millbrook Park for September 2016 please do not forget to log on to e-admissions to officially **accept the place** if you wish to take it. Presently 60 places have been offered. Once those families have responded to their offers we will know if there will be any places which can be offered to those still hoping to join the school. Families will be informed of these second round offers between 23<sup>rd</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> May.

### **Nursery Places 2016**

If you have a younger child turning three before 31st August 2016 and you wish to send them to Millbrook Park Nursery from September 2016 please do not forget to apply to the

school. Application forms are available from the office. Top-ups will also be available from September for you to access extra sessions.

### **Audio Visual Checks for Reception children**

As part of the Department of Health recommendation your child will have a hearing and an eye test. Once tests have been completed you will be informed of the results in writing. If your child needs to be referred for further tests you will be contacted. **Your child will automatically be included in the programme. If you do not wish your child to have a hearing and eye test, please inform the school in writing.**
