Breakfast Club

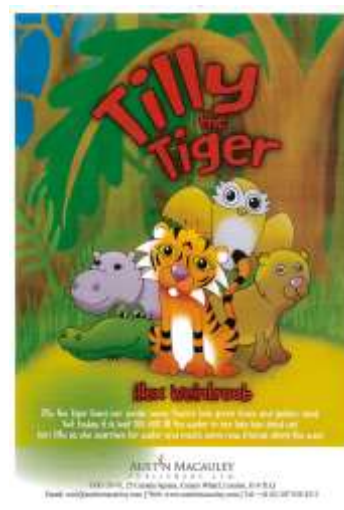

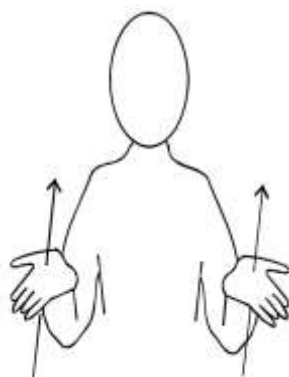


Awards
