The children should be very proud of their achievements. A special well done to Liza for achieving her 75 stars medallion.




Nursery Summer Uniform

Nursery children may wear plain grey school shorts or plain grey soft shorts or a plain grey skirt instead of blue tracksuit bottoms during the summer term, these should be worn with the pale blue school polo shirt. Please also provide them with a sun hat every day to wear outside. Please apply sun cream at home before dropping your child to nursery as the staff are not allowed to apply sun cream to children in their care.
