

Moat House PE Sports Grant Report - 7th September 2017

Moat House Primary School received a Government grant of £9,500 for the academic year 2016/17 plus £3,295 carried forward from the previous year. This funding has been made available to assist the school in improving the provision and quality of PE and sporting activities on offer to the pupils. The funding was spent on

Impact

A set of football nets was purchased to allow a second pitch to be used. Additional resources were purchased through the P.E. budget.

Moat House Leisure Centre sports hall was booked and used by Year 6 children and staff. This has released the school hall timetable and ensured that each class has a full hour of indoor P.E. each week.

The quality of teaching of PE has improved as a result of the upskilling of teachers through procurement of external sports coaches. Teaching is now good with elements of outstanding practice monitored through lesson observations conducted by external consultants and the P.E Co-ordinator.

Fitness levels are now being monitored and recorded across the school from Reception to Year 6 through a rigorous process of assessment.

There was a 14% increase in the number of children participating in after school sporting clubs compared to the previous year.

Planned expenditure for 2017/18 academic year

Premier Sports will be working with Year 2 delivering curriculum content and upskilling teachers. They will also be engaging all children in the Golden Mile.

Coventry Sports Foundation (previously Wasps Rugby Club) will be working with Year 5 and Year 6 children as part of the "Coventry, City of Rugby" initiative.
