**Re: KS1 & KS2 Sports Day – Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019**

**Back up date Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2019**

Dear Parents/Carers,

As detailed on our Newsletter over the course of the year, our Sports Day will take place on **Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019** (weather permitting); with a back up date of **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2019**.

Years 1-6 will take part in many sporting events, throughout the day.

***If your child is in KS1 (Year 1-2) you are invited to join us in the afternoon (2pm onwards)*** to watch your child participate in traditional sports day events such as the Egg & Spoon, Sack and Obstacle races and of course the chance to compete in our Parent/Teacher races. Your child will bring home a slip stating which event they are taking part in so you know which events to look out for. After the events have taken place your child will then go back to class to be dismissed at the end of the day as usual.

***If your child is in KS2 (Year 3-6) you are invited to join us in the morning (09.30am – 11.00am)*** to watch your child take part in traditional Athletics Events e.g. Long Jump, Hurdles, Sprint etc. Your child will bring home a slip stating which event they are taking part in (they will have chosen with their class) as there will be two viewing areas – one for track events and one for field events.

**You will receive a map upon entry and parent viewing areas will be clearly marked. Please ensure that you remain in these areas to guarantee the smooth running of the day.**

As Sports Day will take place all day, your child will need to come into school in his/her sports kit. All children are required to wear:

- A t-shirt in their 'PE Team colour' - **Red, Blue, Green** or **Yellow**. The children know their PE Team colour. If you struggle to find a t-shirt in your child's colour they can borrow a bib from school. However, please note we do not have enough bibs for every child; therefore we would be grateful if you could send your child in their appropriate team colour.
- blue or black PE shorts or sports bottoms
- appropriate trainers (**no hi-tops or Converse**)
- a hat and sun cream (if required)
- a water bottle
