Year 2 Trip to Blackpool

This term we have been learning about the Victorians and the Seaside. To support the children's understanding of the location of the seaside and how life has changed since the Victorian times, we would like to take the children to Blackpool beach for a day of fun!

During the day we will walk along the promenade and pier, visit the beach and go to see Blackpool Tower.

The visits will take place on the following days:

Chestnut 1 - Monday 8th July

Chestnut 2 - Monday 15th July

Chestnut 3 - Tuesday 9th July

We will be travelling in the school's minibuses and will be leaving school soon after morning registration, therefore please ensure your child arrives promptly at 8.45am. We will return in time for home time.

Children will be provided with a school packed lunch to take with them. If your child is on packed lunches already they can bring one with them but in a named plastic bag please with plastic bottles, no glass.

Whilst in Blackpool, we would like the children to experience as much as possible and therefore ask for children to bring **£3 on the day** to buy an ice cream and ride the carousel. We also kindly ask for contributions of **£4** to cover the cost of the school's minibus. Payments can be made via Parent Pay or by collecting a barcode letter from the office. By making this payment, you are giving your consent for your child to attend the visit.

As we will be visiting the beach we ask that the children wear their school top (T-shirt or jumper) and comfortable bottoms of their choice with sensible shoes or trainers. Please ensure your child is dressed for unpredictable weather conditions.
