

Geography: Human and Physical features and the local area

Essentials for this subject:

- To know where the UK is located and that it consists of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
- Use of map skills.
- Looking at Human features of an area, as well as the Physical features.
- To understand that regions change overtime and that change is continuous.
- To explain how the local area has changed and how it might change in the future.

Science : Earth, Space and Forces

Essentials for this subject:

- To describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.
 - To describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.
 - To research and describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies.
 - To describe the Earth in relation to the seasons.
 - To investigate the Solar System.
- Forces
- To explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object.
