

<p style="text-align: center;">Geography: How we are damaging the Planet?</p> <p>Essentials for this subject</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To understand the threats to the health of our planet and some possible solutions - To understand the importance of protecting the oceans - To understand the different types of energy available and their advantages and disadvantages -To carry out an enquiry into sustainability - To research endangered animals - To write to Theresa May about what we can do to help endangered species. <p>-Write a persuasive letter to M.P/ Mrs Haslam about road safety/ traffic pollution around our school.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science : Light and Electricity</p> <p>Essentials for this subject</p> <p><u>Light</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines - Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out / reflect light into the eye - Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes -Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Electricity</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit - Compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches - Use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.
