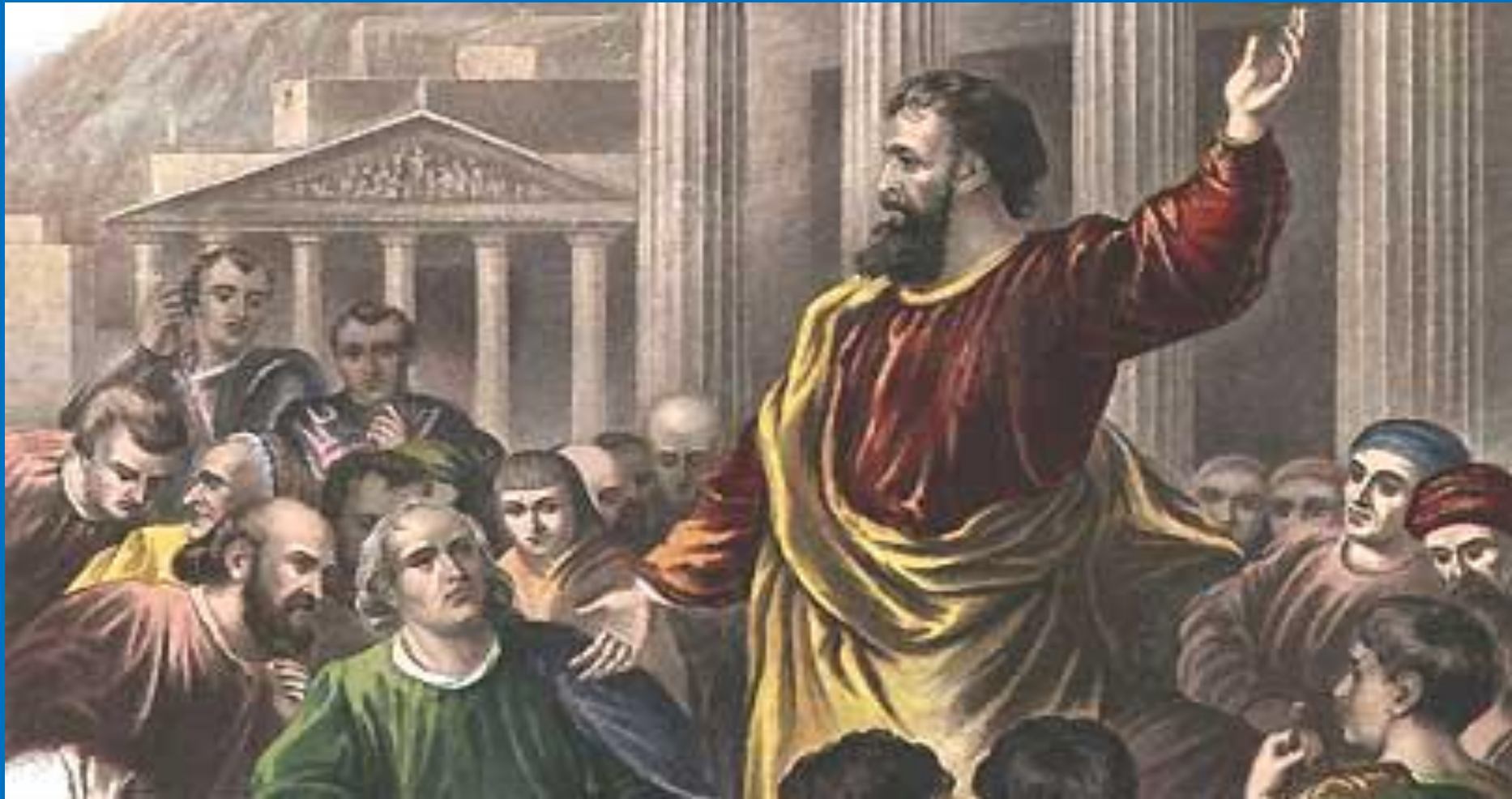
**The Shepherd and his flock.**

The lord is my shepherd, I will not be without the things I need:

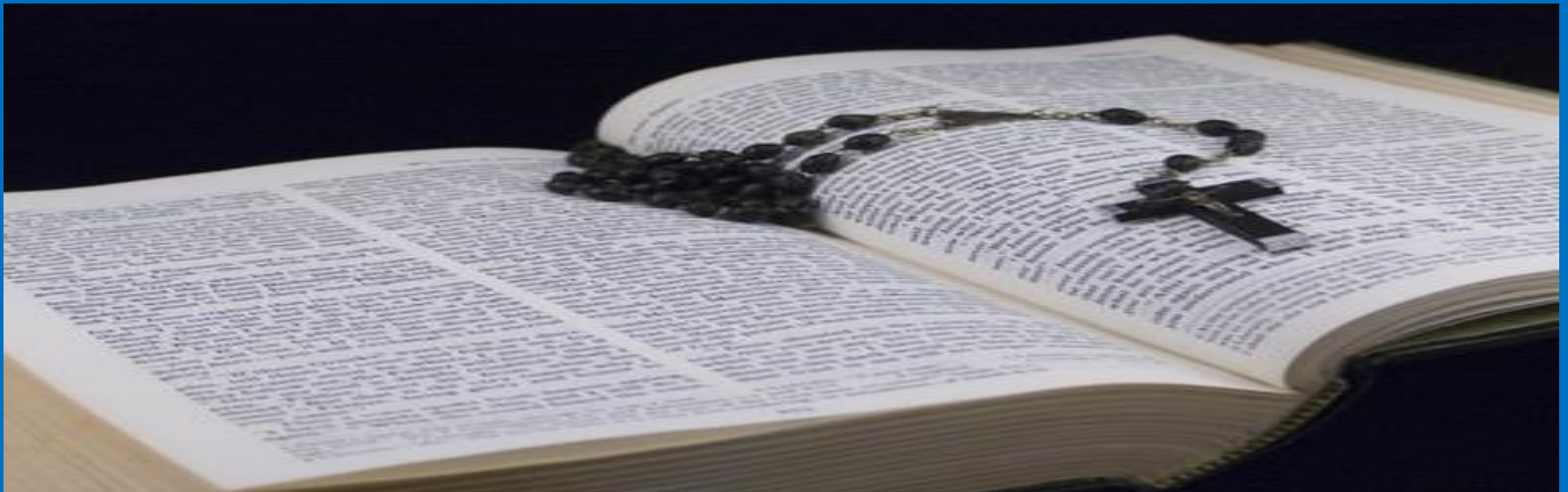
**Response: The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be afraid.**
