The camel and the needle

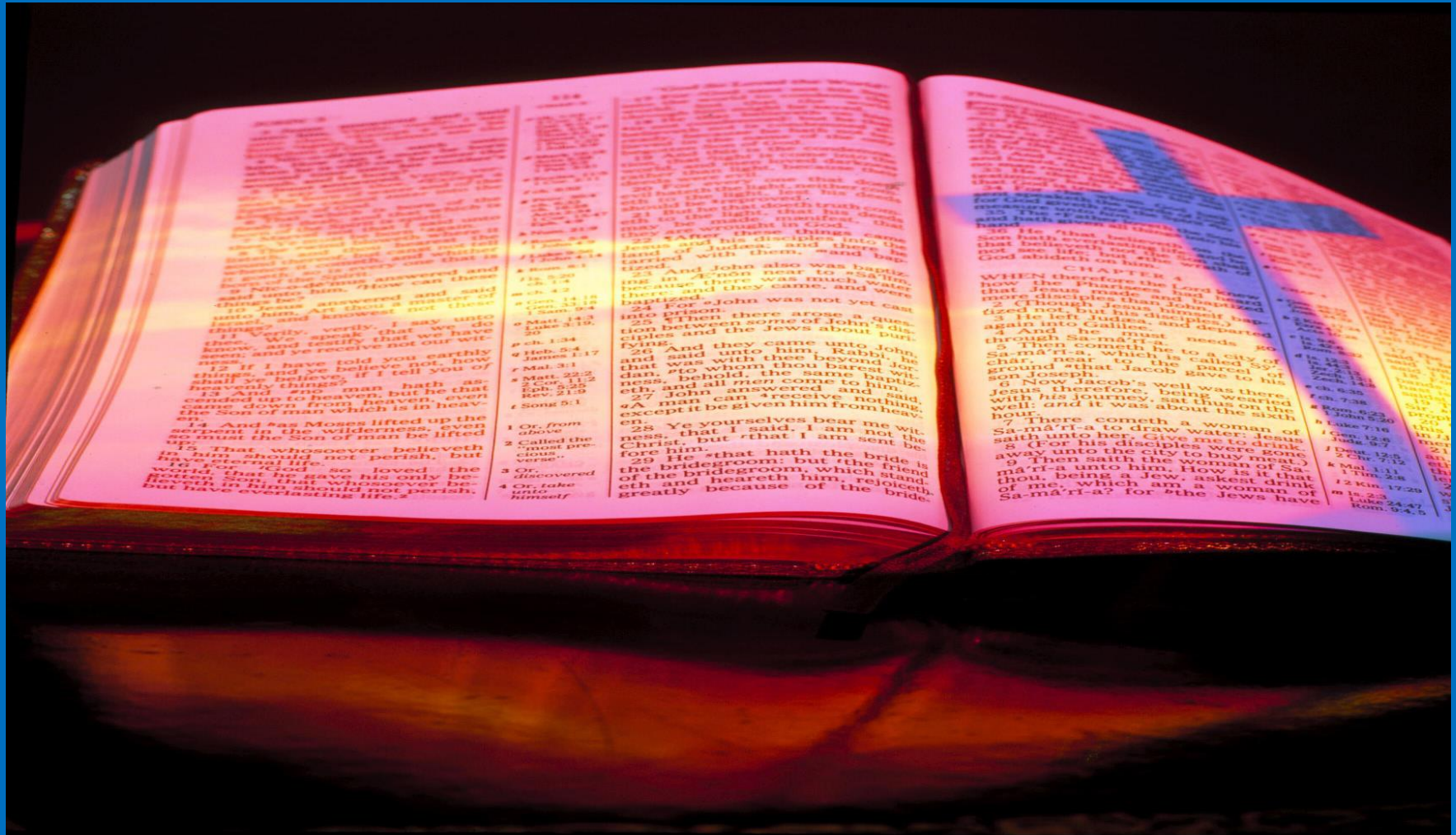
Mark:10:17-25- 'It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle, than for a rich mans to enter the kingdom of heaven!'

The Gospel of the Lord- Mark 10:17-25

Response; Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ



17 And he answered and said unto him, How can these things be? Art thou a master of Israel, and knowest not these things?

18 Jesus answered and said unto him, verily, I say unto thee, all things are possible unto me.

19 We speak that we have seen, and we receive not our witness: and ye believe not our words.

20 If I have told you earthly things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe the things which I say of heavenly things?

21 And such a man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.

22 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

23 That which should not perish, but have everlasting life.

24 For the Son of man gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

25 Then there arose a question between some of John's disciples and the Jews about purifying.

26 And they came unto John, and said unto him, Rabbi, he that was with thee beyond Jordan, behold, the same baptizeth, and all men come to him.

27 John answered and said, A man can receive nothing, except it be given him from heaven.

28 Ye yourselves bear me witness, that I said, I am not the Christ, but that I am sent before him.

29 He that hath the bride is the bridegroom; which standeth and heareth him; rejoiceth greatly because of the bride-

20 He that believeth on the Son of man, shall not perish, but have everlasting life: for God abideth on him.

CHAPTER 11

1 When therefore the Lord knew how the Pharisees had more disciples than John, (though Jesus himself baptized not, but his disciples,) he left Judaea, and departed again into Judaea, and departed through Sa-ma'ri-a.

2 Then cometh he to a city of Sama'ri-a, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.

3 Now Jacob's well was there, with his journey, sat thus on the well; and it was about the sixth hour.

4 There cometh a woman of Sa-ma'ri-a to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink. (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.)

5 Then saith the woman of Sa-ma'ri-a unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Sa-ma'ri-a? for the Jews have
