

At Risley Lower Grammar CE (VC) Primary School we have three rules to make it easy for all children to know how they should behave.

- Be kind
- Be safe
- Be polite

We are all given 20 minutes Golden Time each week where we can choose an activity such as: art work; board games; construction kits; outdoor play; films.

If we break the school rules our names will be moved down the sanctions ladder. The first move is a warning but the second move means we choose to lose some of our Golden Time.

Most of us keep all of our Golden Time which means over a year we can have 13hours of Golden Time! (About 2 ½ School Days)

There is also a rewards ladder where we move our names up if we have been seen to be particularly well behaved. If we get moved up two steps, we get a stamp or a sticker; when we have 10 stamps or stickers we can choose a prize from a prize box.

Each Class has their own class award system which results in a class treat.

Adults at Risley School let us know when we are behaving well by telling us; writing comments in our books; giving house points; smiling at us or giving thumbs up.

We have a Role Model Assembly in January and give class caring awards at the Leavers' Service.

Children are encouraged to sort out their own arguments; they are given time to talk to each other calmly with adult support if needed.
