

Clarification on shoes that are acceptable as part of school uniform

We are aware that many parents have purchased school shoes ready for the new term and we are very grateful to you for ensuring that your child is smartly presented for school. However, there has been some confusion regarding the style of shoe that is acceptable. In order to remedy this, we would like to be clear that the definition of 'formal black shoes' is intended to refer to black leather lace-up or slip-on shoes. Velcro fastening or 'trainer' style shoes are not acceptable. The illustration below should help in clarifying this:
