Divide by 10 and 100 to get a decimal fraction

Multiply three numbers together

Add and subtract money, including mixed units, and give change in practical contexts

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| <p>Learn and perform a song in a different language</p> | <p>Keep a scrapbook of things you do</p> | <p>Conduct a survey and record the data in a tally chart. Then record it in a graph. E.g. log the number of birds that you spot each day. How many creatures can you find in the garden? Remember, don't move anything from its habitat</p> | <p>Research your Family Tree</p> <p>Watch a family movie</p> |
| <p>Make a model out of papier-mâché Paint it to make it look realistic Take a photograph</p> | <p>Safely walk up and down the stairs five times without stopping Create a mini workout to do every day: this could include 5 star jumps, running on the spot, Skipping and Burpies</p> | <p>Make a sea creature using recycled materials</p> | <p>Prepare and eat a healthy snack for breakfast, lunch and dinner</p> <p>Find out what makes a balanced diet</p> <p>Make a hot cross bun or a scone</p> <p>Keep a food diary and notice what happens as certain foods (like beetroot, sweetcorn, asparagus or blueberries) pass through your body</p> |
| <p>Find out about the Easter story and why Christians celebrate Easter</p> <p>Make an Easter Bonnet</p> <p>Make up your own clues for an Easter Treasure Hunt</p> | <p>Enter a competition</p> | <p>Find out what happens to eggshells when you leave it in different liquids for two weeks. Use vinegar, apple juice, water, milk Make a prediction. Record your observations using pictures or photographs Do not touch the liquids, but after two weeks examine the eggshells. Which liquid has done the most damage? Record your results</p> | <p>Grow your own fruit or vegetables</p> |
