## EVERY DAY I MUST...

Read with an adult and discuss the front cover, characters and storyline.

Choose a different letter sound and practise writing words with the same sound.

These can be found in your reading diaries and letters and sounds books.

Practise learning your number bonds to 10 or 20 and learn the inverse too.

E.g.  $2 + 8 = 10$     $10 - 2 = 8$     $10 - 2 = 8$

Complete a puzzle or play a turn-taking game. Try to use one you haven't done for ages! Or swap games with a friend and try a new one.

## EVERY DAY I SHOULD TRY ONE OR TWO...

Draw a map of where I live and give instructions to someone on how to get somewhere within my map.	Find out about what you recycle at home and why. Learn about where different materials come from.	Follow a recipe and measure out ingredients carefully	Pick 2 numbers between 10 and 50 and add or subtract them.
Explore in your local area for signs of Spring and make a labelled picture.	Log onto cosmic yoga and get all the family moving.	Design an obstacle course in your garden or park and test it. Challenge a friend to beat your time.	Design a comic book about your favourite cartoon characters with speech bubbles.
Find out about another city around the world and write a fact file. Draw or cut and stick pictures.	Practise cursive handwriting. Copy out a favourite rhyme or poem. You could give it a border and present it neatly.	Practise 10 spellings. Find key words in your reading diaries or letters and sounds book. Write a sentence using them.	Draw a picture of someone you know using different mediums. Create a gallery of art on your wall.
Find out about the meaning of Easter and make an Easter Garden.	Make a healthy snack for you and a friend or family member.	Make up an exercise routine to music and get friends and family to do it.	Write a postcard or letter and send it to Mrs Mead and Mrs McCann to read at school.

## TO CHALLENGE MYSELF, I COULD...

Make a model of a landmark from anywhere around the world. You could use recycled materials or Lego, papier-mâché or sticks. Take a photo.

Write a story about you going on an adventure around the world. It could be about you going to an exciting city, how will you get there and what will you see?

Make a board game on some cardboard, with rules for your family and friends to play.
