TO CHALLENGE MYSELF, I COULD...

Imagine you are an evacuee: you are allowed to take just one book with you to your new home. Which one would you take? Conduct a survey amongst family and friends to find out which book they would choose and why.

Make a scrapbook of Second World War images and write captions for each one. Consider how the people in the photographs may be feeling.

Dress up as an evacuated child. Make a gas mask box using brown paper to cover and write an evacuee label showing your name, address and school.

Ask someone to take a photograph then print it with a sepia effect to make it look authentic!
