



# Year Two Home Learning

## EVERY DAY I MUST...

### Writing

Either plan your day, thinking about what you would like to do, or write about the day that you have had.

Make sure that you are using the correct punctuation (capital letters, apostrophe for possession and omission, question and exclamation marks) and using a range of conjunctions to extend a sentence (but. so. and. because).

### Maths

- 🌳 Practice adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers less than 100
- 🌳 Solve addition and subtraction word problems
- 🌳 Solve multiplication and division problems using multiples of 2, 5 or 10
- 🌳 Use objects to share into equal groups that represent halves, quarters, thirds. Add halves, quarters and thirds to make a whole

### Reading

- 🌳 Reread a familiar text and think about the words or phrases that an author has used to describe a character
- 🌳 Compare stories by the same author – what themes are similar? How are the characters similar or different in the stories?

### PE

- 🌳 Spend at least 15 minutes engaged in a physical activity that will get your heart beating faster
- 🌳 Spend some time on your own being mindful

## EVERY DAY I SHOULD TRY ONE OR TWO...

### Science

Make a potato head using cress. How long can you keep it healthy?

### Design and Technology

Design and create your own bright and colourful carnival outfit. Use old clothes, unwanted fabrics and any other fabulous decorations, such as feathers or sequins.

### English

Create your own Brazilian Recipe Book. Find some Brazilian recipes online and try making them with your family. When writing your recipe think about writing a simple description of your creation and then, when writing your instructions, think about your choice of imperative verbs and fronted adverbials.

### Maths

Using a pack of cards, with picture and ace cards removed, select 3 or 4 cards to create an addition or subtraction equation. Draw attention to the ones digit – would you need to regroup or exchange a ten? Refer to our calculation policy for teaching support.

### French

Make a poster about France. Think about common phrases, sights and sounds that you would experience if you were to visit France.

### Art

Look at images of Brazilian plants and flowers, such as orchids or cacti. Create a scrapbook using a range of media (watercolours, crayon, pencil, crayon or collage).

### Spellings

Create spelling posters of words that we are learning this term taken from our Pathway to Spelling document. How many other words can you find that have the same spelling pattern?

### History

Learn different ways to access the news and keep a timeline of local or world events. You might want to use Microsoft PowerPoint to create a page for each day. Learn how to insert pictures and text, you can even change the font and colour to create interest.



### Maths

Create a small business using £10. Produce a design of what you would like to make and sell, make the packaging including a sales description, keep a budget of what you have spent and how much you have left and earned.

### English

Imagine you are on holiday in Rio during the carnival. Write a postcard to a friend, telling them all about the sights and sounds you have experienced. Draw a Rio scene on the front of your postcard using downloaded images as inspiration.

### Science

Dissect a plant and identify the flower, leaves, stem and roots.  
Sketch your observations and look closely at the flower, what can you see?

### Music

Research famous landmarks from Brazil and produce your own Brazilian song. As a challenge, could you use an instrument to accompany the lyrics?
