Sports Premium Statement 2016/2017

The Department of Education is providing all primary schools with additional funding to improve the provision of PE and sport. The funding calculation is based on the number of children at the school.

PE funding is allocated to schools for all children to benefit from a wide and varied PE curriculum to encourage achievement and a healthy lifestyle.

Sacred Heart Primary School Objectives of spending Sports Premium Funding:

Vision: ALL pupils leaving Sacred Heart primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

Objective: To achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport at Sacred Heart against 5 key indicators:

1. Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
2. Raise the profile of PE and sport across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of staff in teaching PE and sport
4. Broader range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. Increased participation in competitive sport
