




## Pupil Questionnaire: Results for November 2018

One of the things which always pleases me when I complete questionnaires with children is their confidence in telling us their thoughts about the school, whether positive or negative. It shows high levels of self-esteem and confidence in the leaders of the school to listen to their opinion.



In November 2018, 74 Key Stage pupils answered the questionnaire.

As a **telling school**, we encourage pupils to tell us things that are going well and areas to improve to make us a better school.



- 100% of the pupils feel that they can share their concerns with an adult in school. Worry boxes have been introduced to all Key Stage 2 classes this academic year.
- 100% of pupils feel safe in school.
- For any pupil who didn't enjoy school, an adult spoke to them 1:1 to see if any concerns were raised. Answers were generally "I don't mind coming to school but I would rather be at home with my pet/ family etc)
- There is a significant increase in the number of pupils who feel that behaviour is good at the school (now 99% of pupils).

#### Next steps

- Now the school needs to review ways in which we can improve sharing how well a pupil is achieving.
