## Uniform

I cannot emphasise strongly enough how important it is to put your child's name in each article of clothing they bring into school.

Last week we washed six loads of unnamed uniform which we will use as spare items of clothing in school. Whilst it is very useful to have all of this spare clothing, it is a concern that so much money has been spent by families and the 'lost' items cannot be returned to their rightful owners because they are unnamed.

Could I also ask you to return spare clothing that has come home if your child has needed a change of clothes in school. We are really short of KS1 trousers and underwear because we are not getting the spare clothing back. The majority of children do manage to keep track of their underwear during the school day, so these items were not in the pile of unclaimed clothes!

## Fitness Trackers

Lots of children seem to have had fitness trackers as Christmas presents this year which is a great idea as an encouragement to keep active. Some of the children are getting quite competitive about the number of steps they are taking each day which is great to see. I am happy for children to wear fitness trackers for school, but they are the responsibility of individual children and the school cannot be responsible for their safety.

One or two children have brought in watches which have games on them. These are not such a good idea as they are a distraction as well as being quite expensive items if they go missing or get broken. Perhaps these are better kept for home use, so please don't let the children bring them in.

## Anaphylaxis

We updated our training in staff meeting this week. We do have some children in school with allergies to different kinds of food. Therefore we discourage the children from sharing snacks to avoid potential problems. Please remember that the school is nut free. Food containing nuts, such as breakfast bars, shouldn't be sent into school. Thanks for your co-operation with this.
