## What is Sports Premium?

From April 2013 each school in England received a block sum of £8000 plus £5 per pupil. This money is to be used to support better standards of physical education and greater participation. Below is a summary of how monies will be spent for this academic year 2016-2017.

Lacon Sports Partnership	£3700	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Quality of teaching and learning is supported by specialised sports staff who work alongside staff. Provision is consistently good or better as a result. With a high staff turnover we will have some specialised training for our own staff - see below.</li> </ul>
Additional staffing costs to increase access across classes, to target specific groups or ensure adult ratios when going to hall facilities nearby.	£770	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In order to get younger active involvement in some opportunities this means splitting 'home' classes for access. For example our Y3 pupils going with Y4; our Y5 going with Y6; pupils going from across KS2 for Change for Life. Additional TA time is needed to accompany and facilitate this</li> </ul>
Transport and hall hire to Willowdene (Partnership festivals/competitions and opportunities)	£4000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As a small rural school, transporting pupils to sporting events with other schools will always be a significant cost but it is also very beneficial sports wise, personally and socially and as part of secondary transition.</li> <li>As an academy we have secured funds from a school house sale (in trust to the school) and submitted a bid to Academy capital funds to provide our own hall facilities. This would mean a considerable reduction in transport costs and hall hire costs.</li> <li>The MAT has an increasing bank of minibuses which it uses to support transportation costs.</li> <li>Our PTA fundraising is also helping in supporting with costs in this area.</li> </ul>

- Attainment, achievement, enjoyment and participation in sport continue to be a strength of the school.
- On average 90% of children meet age related expectations (20% achieve mastery)

As a school we pay £3700 out of the Sports Premium funding to be part of the Lacon Childe School Sports Partnership. As part of this group we access a wide range of provision that enables us as a school to ensure we are making effective use of the funding.

## The Offer

### Physical Education and Curriculum Support

**Primary Outreach** - Schools are bussed into Lacon Childe School to participate in units of work delivered by Primary PE specialist making use of the secondary school facilities. This year children will benefit from gymnastic units for our older pupils (Y4 - 6) which we cannot provide on our own site. Transportation costs have been funded by the grant.

**Community Sports Coach** - The community sports coach delivers PE in schools for half term blocks. The coach delivers units in the curriculum and is a source of effective CPD for the teachers. The coach delivers 2x1hr sessions in an afternoon enabling 2 classes to access the support followed by an after school club. This year the school will benefit from Invasion Game Units, gymnastic units and cricket units during 3 out of 6 half terms. Transitional Support - Working closely with Lacon Childe School ensures the links with the secondary school are strong and the children have less worry when making the transition for KS2 - KS3.

### Out of School Hours Learning

The school has a range of sports clubs through the year (basketball, netball, hockey, football, rugby, change 4 life, multi-sport (dodgeball; cricket; Frisbee etc), Tri Golf which the coach contributes to.

### Competition and Talent

A significant programme of localised competition is available to each school. There is provision for all age groups from Reception to Year 6 - see below

There is continued engagement in the national initiative, School Games. This is achieved through local competition based in the Lacon Childe family leading into South Shropshire competition and the winning teams going forward to the Level 3 school games event - see below. Transportation costs will be funded by the grant.

### Leadership

Years 4 - 6 will, once again, participate in leadership training. This will skill the children to be able to act as playground leaders and organise playtime activities for other children. This has been on the increase with children organising their own cricket tournament.

### Raising Achievement

Team teaching and observing PE specialists is planned in different areas to help staff gain valuable subject knowledge and the skills to deliver outstanding PE lessons.
