

**Art: Pablo Picasso and self portraits**  
 We will be looking at the work of Pablo Picasso and learning how to paint self-portraits in a similar style. We will take a trip to the National Portrait Gallery to learn more about self-portraiture before attempting our own.

The final week of the half term will be Art Week where we will take part in lots of different art activities.

**Literacy:**  
 This half term we will be looking at traditional fairy tales in some detail- retelling, making comparisons and describing characters and settings. We will be looking at familiar structures and fairy tale language before playing around with the structure and the characters to write our own mixed up, twisted tales.

**Geography: Around the world**  
 We will be learning about the 7 continents and 5 oceans and locating different countries on the map. We will be looking at the different versions of the Cinderella story from around the world, focusing on a country from each continent. We will be learning about traditional culture in each of the focus countries. This will link to the music we listen to each week as well.

**Science: The human body**  
 We will be comparing living and non-living things, learning about the human body and the basic needs of animals and humans to stay alive. We will also be looking at the importance of exercise and hygiene for humans.



**Music: Musical appreciation**  
 We will be focusing on musical appreciation this half term; listening and responding to different genres of music from around the world. Each week we will be looking at a country from a different continent to correspond with the countries we are learning about in Geography.

**PE: Games**  
 We will be playing circle games and other active games to develop our ability to follow instructions and use space effectively, while also developing our fitness.

**PSHE: New Beginnings**  
 We will be exploring our feelings and those of others and discussing how to manage them and problem solve. We will be focusing on the school Rule 'We are kind', in order to help manage and develop friendships.

**Religious Education: Rules and Laws**  
 We will be looking at the importance and difference between rules and laws, setting our intentions for following the Soho Parish Rules this year. We will link this to looking at rules and customs in different religions, specifically Harvest in the Christian faith and other religions. We will think about those who are less fortunate than ourselves and the importance of sharing.
