Kingswood children were wonderful at persuading each other to go out of their comfort zone. The assembly was funny, jolly and happy!

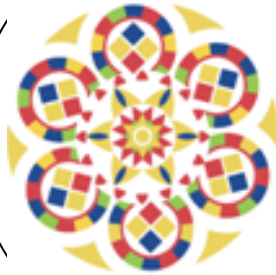


Actions:
