### RED NOSE DAY - Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March

These are the activities we are planning to raise money for Comic Relief.

On Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March TK MAXX will be selling Red Nose Day t-shirts in school. These will be on sale in the Saxby Hall from 8.30 to 9.15 am and from 2.30 to 3.30 pm.

Red Noses will be on sale in both buildings every day from Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March. These cost £1.25. If possible, please bring the right money.

We will be selling second hand children's books on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> before and after school. This will be in the Saxby building Year 2 cloakroom area. Children can bring money on these days if they want to buy books. All books will cost 20p.

On Red Nose Day (Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March), cakes will be on sale in both buildings from 8.30 am. In Saxby, these will be in the Year 2 cloakroom area as usual.

For a £1.00 donation, children can dress up in something funny, something red or just non-uniform. If children want to buy cakes on Friday, they can bring extra money.

There will be activities in classes in the afternoon.

### SECURITY

We have had a new security system fitted in the Saxby building which will mean a few small changes to access to the school.

Starting next week, all doors to classrooms will automatically unlock at 8.30 am and then automatically lock at 8.45 am. Getting into school will be the same as it is now except all doors will unlock and lock at the same time.

After the doors have locked at 8.45 am, parents will not be able to go out through the outside doors. If any parents are in the building after 8.45 am, this is not a problem, you will just need to go out through the office area. If you are late, please use the main entrance on Saxby Street as usual.

All doors to the building will automatically open again at 3.00 pm.
