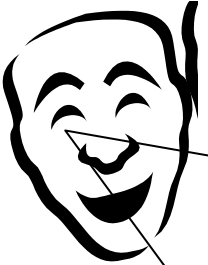




SCHOOL COUNCIL NEWS

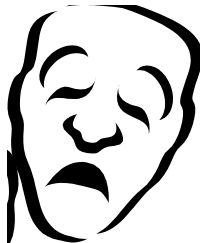
Y5 went to Leicester Tigers to meet Tommy Donbavand – author of 'Scream Street'.
